

On February 10, 2014, Workforce Alliance staff emailed the WIA Oversight/Youth Council, requesting action on an item.

1. Addition to the Eligible Training Provider (ETP) List

Allied Health requested the addition of their phlebotomy program to the ETP list. The program awards a certificate, requires 120 credit/curriculum hours, with a total cost of approximately \$800 to complete. Following certification, participants can earn \$14.13 per hour, exceeding the Local Area IV self-sustaining wage.

Workforce Alliance staff recommends approval of the addition to the ETP list.

Unanimous approval was received from the WIA Oversight/Youth Council to authorize the addition of the Allied Health Phlebotomy program to the ETP list.
