WICHITA WORKFORCE CENTER TO EXPAND HOURS OF OPERATION

WICHITA, KS - The Wichita Workforce Center, 2021 N. Amidon Suite 1100, will expand hours of operation beginning April 3, 2017. The new hours will be Monday – Thursday 7 am – 6 pm and Friday 9 am – Noon, Closed on Saturday and Sunday.

The expanded hours will allow job seekers who are not available during normal business hours to access the Workforce Center. The Workforce Center is a one-stop location offering services to job seekers and employers. Services available at the Workforce Center for job seekers include resume reviews, mock interviews and workshops such as Basic Computers, Resume Writing, Microsoft Word and Excel.
