#1 Does CDL Training fall within this grant for training?

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) identified CDL Class A and CDL Class B as eligible trainings for environmental cleanup. Workforce Alliance of South Central Kansas, Inc. (WA) can fund training for up to 20 individuals in CDL Class A or CDL Class B through the EPA Brownfields Job Training Program.

#2 What details are needed in the proposal?

The requirements of the proposals are section 4 of the RFP and include:

#3 Is sanitation driving part of the Environmental Clean Up space for training?

Sanitation driver certification is not identified by EPA as a supported credential under this grant. The only EPA-identified supported trainings are CDL Class A and CDL Class B.

#4 Is WA open to ideas for the use of the funds?

*No. The EPA restricts the use of funds to training areas identified in the RFP. Specifically, see **page 7, Section 3.1**, which lists the allowable training areas. Proposals must align with these approved categories.*
