Official Responses

#1 Does CDL Training fall within this grant for training?

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) identified CDL Class A and CDL Class B as eligible trainings for environmental cleanup. Workforce Alliance of South Central Kansas, Inc. (WA) can fund training for up to 20 individuals in CDL Class A or CDL Class B through the EPA Brownfields Job Training Program.

What details are needed in the proposal?

The requirements of the proposals are section 4 of the RFP and include:

- A. Title Page, Table of Contents, and Executive Summary
- B. Business Description and Qualifications
- C. Program Content
- D. Program Design
- E. Past Performance
- F. Costs

#3 Is sanitation driving part of the Environmental Clean Up space for training?

Sanitation driver certification is not identified by EPA as a supported credential under this grant. The only EPA-identified supported trainings are CDL Class A and CDL Class B.

#4 Is WA open to ideas for the use of the funds?

No. The EPA restricts the use of funds to training areas identified in the RFP. Specifically, see page 7, Section 3.1, which lists the allowable training areas. Proposals must align with these approved categories.
