

#### **Executive Summary**

The goal of the Workforce Alliance of South Central Kansas (WA), the Local Workforce Development Board serving Local Area IV, is to leverage resources and align services to increase the community impact of the annual Federal allocation from the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). At the direction of the WA Board of Directors, staff and Workforce Center partners seek opportunities to secure grants and collaborate on training projects to bring more funding to the region. The result is job seekers in Local Area IV have access to a number of different employment and training programs.


This report summarizes the number of people currently in training, the occupation and employment sectors of the training, the education and training providers, and expended funds. Training includes Incumbent Worker Training, On-the-Job Training, Occupational Skills Training, and Registered Apprenticeship. The report found that while the number of participants in traditional classroom training continues to decrease, participation in Work-Based Learning continues to increase particularly in Registered Apprenticeship and Incumbent Worker Training. This is also borne out in the fact that the WA has expanded its RA involvement adding three apprentices since the Spring Report.

For Program Year 2024, 46 percent of the budget is from the annual WIOA allocation, and the balance comes from other grants and special projects. The projects and programs that are currently being leveraged and funding skills training in Local Area IV are:

- Home Base Wichita
- MeadowLARK Registered Apprenticeship Grant
- One Workforce Grant
- Retaining Employment and Talent After Injury/Illness Network (RETAIN)
- State Apprenticeship Expansion, Equity, and Innovation (SAEEI)
- Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA)<sup>1</sup>
- WIOA Adult, Dislocated Worker, Youth


