Early Medical Intervention is Key to Preventing Long-Term Disability

Many ill and injured workers are able to remain in their jobs or the workforce when they receive timely, coordinated employment support and medical services as part of a stay-at-work or return-to-work program. RETAINWORKS focuses on the supporting the continued employment of individuals who experience illness or injury that will potentially result in a work disability.

Healthcare Providers Play a Crucial Role in RETAINWORKS

A healthcare provider's primary goal is their patient's recovery. A coordinated effort with the patient and their employer helps achieve that goal. By assisting the patient's return to work under medical supervision as soon as possible, employment becomes an important health outcome. Healthcare providers can get involved by referring eligible patients within 12 weeks of illness or injury and collaborating with the RETAINWORKS network to improve their employment outcomes.

You and your eligible patients will work with a team of RETAINWORKS Navigators to treat the entire person, not just their illness or injury.
