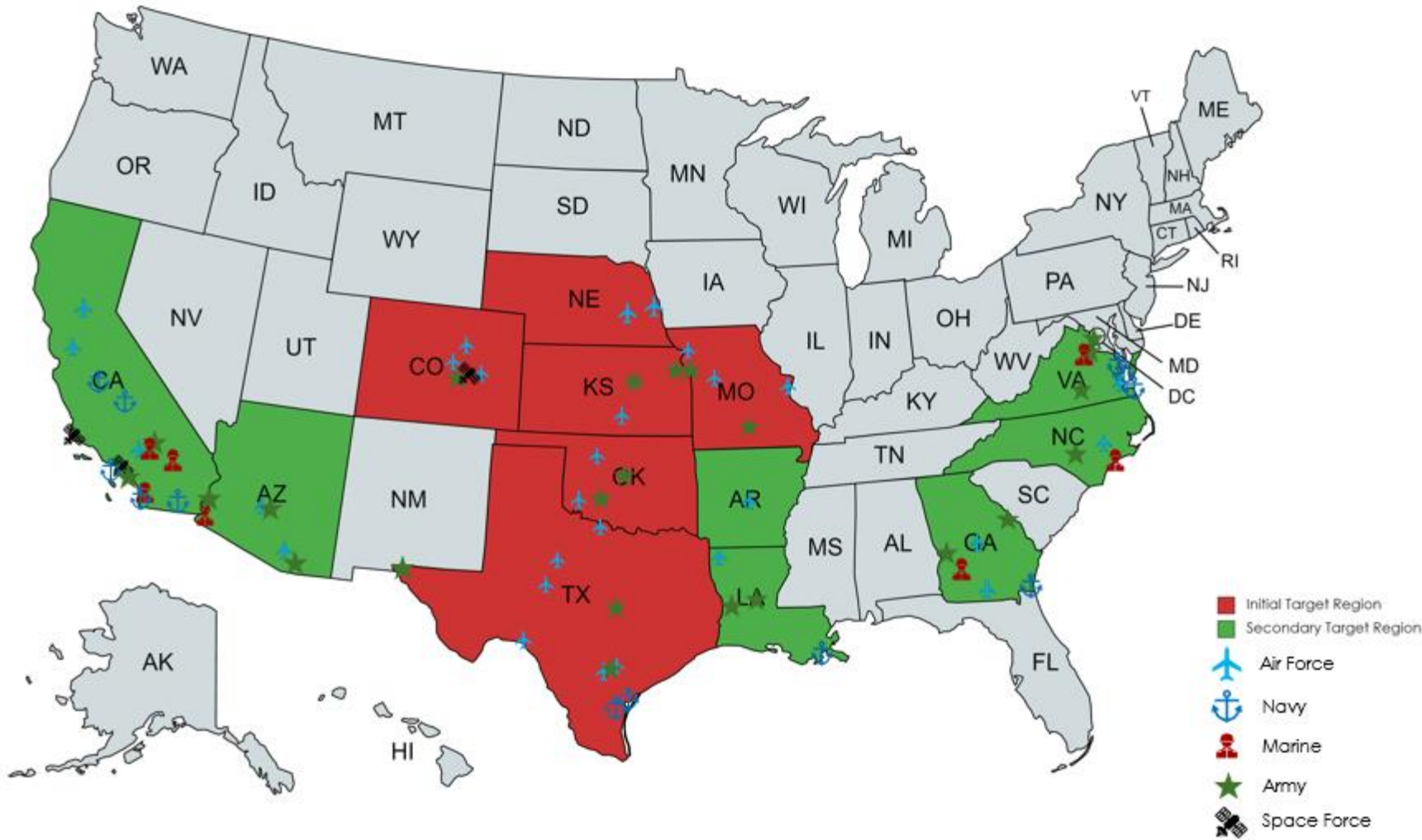
## DEFINING THE TALENT CATEGORIES



- **Transitioning Military:** Is still serving in the military, but has made the decision to exit military service at the next opportunity. From 1-18 months away from availability to work. Can be Active Duty, National Guard, or Reservist.
- **Veteran:** Is no longer serving active duty. Has exited active duty service for any length of time, and at any point in the past.
- **National Guard/Reservist:** Currently serving in the National Guard or Reserve of any branch. Typically drills one weekend per month and two consecutive weeks per year. Can be called to active duty if State or Federal Government orders.
- **Military Spouse:** Is married to a service member of any branch, active duty, Guard or Reserve.
- **Student Veteran:** Similar to Transitioning Military, can be 1-18 months away from graduation date with specific skills or degree. Has served in any branch for any length of time.

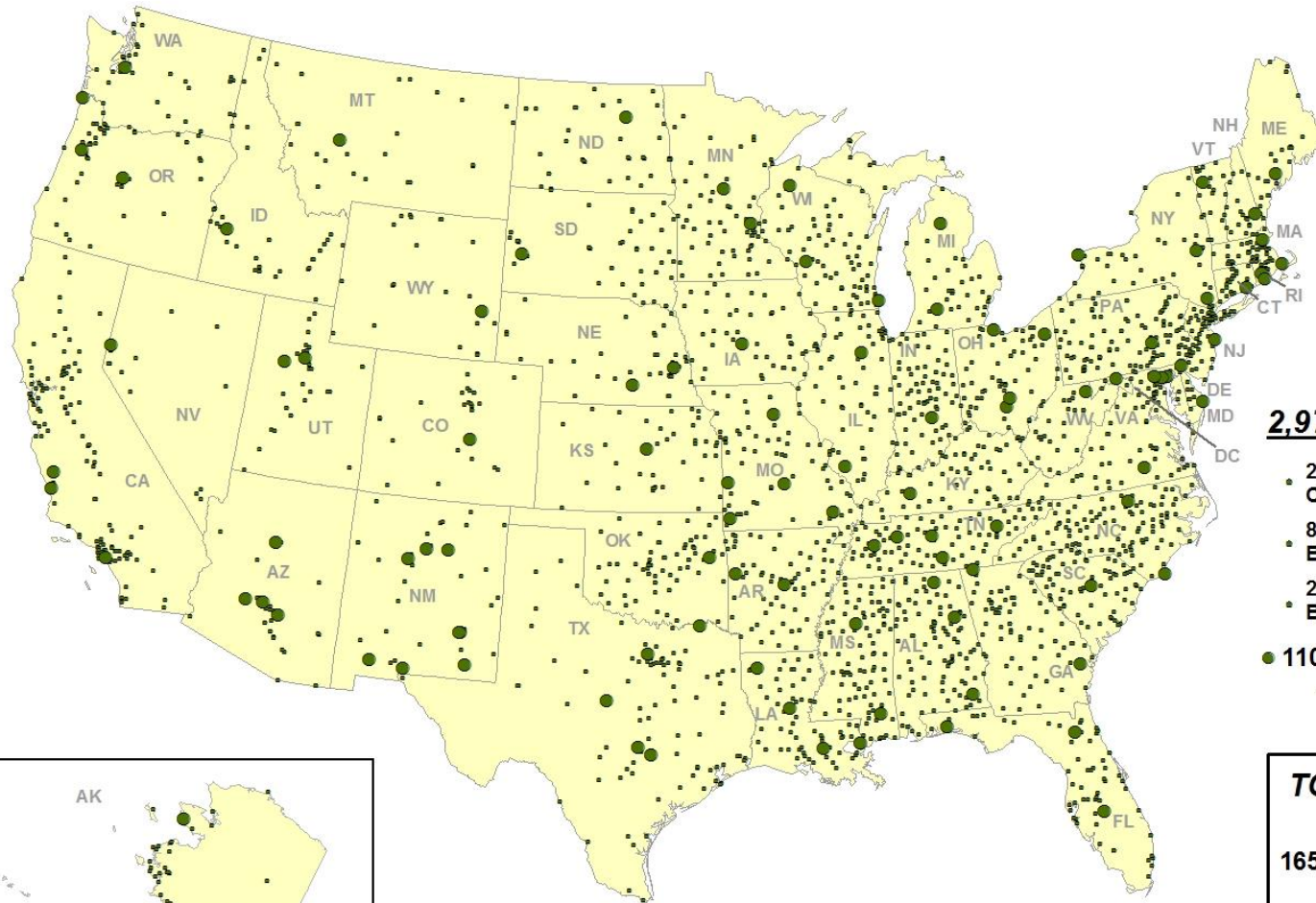

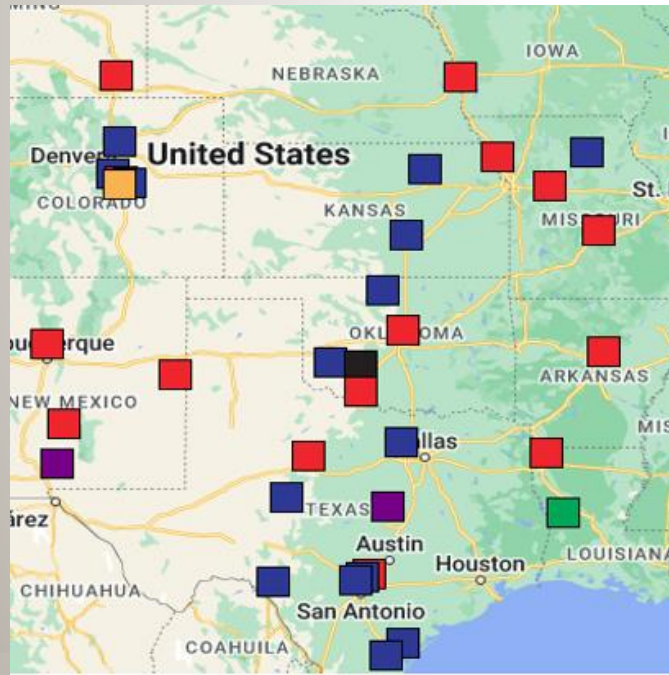
