- Expand and formalize WBL Internship Opportunities within YEP
  - Strategically connect summer internship placements based on CTE/academic interests
    - Grow partnership with Wichita Public Schools and Districts in the region
    - Partner with Chambers of Commerce, Eco Devo organizations, local governments and area employer organizations for Business Recruitment
    - Report data breakdown separately for Internship vs Part-time/Seasonal Employment





- Integrate Road Trip Nation (RTN) Curriculum
  - YEP Staff will utilize RTN with students in the classroom encounters for WBL
  - RTN curriculum will be integrated into all Camp HYPE sessions
  - Greater emphasis on student video interviews and added \$50 incentive for Camp HYPE
  - WA employer partners will be called up on to assist with video interviews





- Expanded Camp HYPE to engage younger youth in career exploration activities (based on resources and capacity)
  - Offer additional industries for Finance/Insurance/Real Estate
  - Offer additional Sessions outside Sedgwick County if funding is secured





- Introduction of Virtual Career Exploration
  - TRANSFR Headsets will be used beginning in 2024
  - Use at Career Booths and in Camp HYEP
  - Available to WIOA Youth participants
